The Qianlong Period teapot, finely painted at the London decorating workshop of James Giles, with vibrantly enamelled scenes of exotic birds, amongst flowering plants, in a landscape. Other birds, flying in the distance. The cover, similarly decorated, with a bird perched upon a branch, with two further birds in flight. Surmounted with a tear drop finial. Medium: Porcelain Height: 13.5 cm, 5 1/4". Width: 21.5 cm, 8 1/2". Depth: 11 cm, 4 3/8". Condition: Glaze fritting to the finial - please see images for detail. No restoration.
