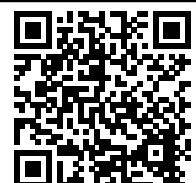
A stunning cut glass bonbonniere or sweetmeat jar, from the end of the Victorian era. This superb piece has a goblet shaped body with a turned over rim and castellated border. The foot is octagonal and there is a multi point star cut to the base. The body and lid are cut with thumbnails and the lid has a superb cut steeple, blown with a teardrop - echoed in the cut stem. The lid has the etched figure of a man in robes with a book and staff. Bonbonniere's were high quality items for the serving table, containing bonbons or sweetmeats, but would serve well for other uses. An outstanding example, both practical and decorative.
