Description

Silver J W Benson pocket watch, 1930. The watch has a 15-jewel stem-winding movement, identified as by Revue, which is working nicely. The movement is signed J W Benson, the original retailer of the watch, and it is all protected by an inner hinged cover. The inner cover has a scratch, probably where someone has opened it in the past. The watch measures 49mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the two hinged case backs for Birmingham 1930 with a case maker's mark for Aaron Dennison. Dennisons was a Birmingham based case maker who supplied various watch makers with cases. The case is in good condition, just a little unevenness to the back. The glass lens is in good condition. The dial is signed J W Benson, and it is in lovely condition, just a shade of discolouration to the subsidiary seconds dial. J W Benson originated in 1847, founded by James William Benson and Samuel Suckley Benson. They were regarded as one of Victorian London's most prestigious retail jewellers and they also manufactured their own watch movements. The company flourished and proudly boasted an elite client base made up of bot...
