Van der Weele moved to The Hague when he was twenty and became a student of the Art Academy The Hague. He received advice from Johannes Bosboom and Anton Mauve, who's influence can be seen in his work. Van der Weele mainly painted landscapes, genre scenes and animals. He was a member of the artist association Arti et Amicitiae Amsterdam. He was a close friend of George Hendrik Breitner, who dedicated his 'Self-portrait with Lorgnette' to him

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
