Very clear hallmarks for the Birmingham Assay Office are visible on the inside base, with a date mark for 1900 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. The silversmith's maker's marks are also very clear for Adie & Lovekin Ltd. The Lion Passant and date mark can also be seen on the side of the lid. Condition: In lovely condition.
