Description

Unusual early C19th George IV period marble-topped rosewood console table of small proportions. Fitted with an inset 'Verde Mare' green marble top within a moulded surround, above an unusual carved and pierced frieze and drawer fitted with painted blue glass landscape panels. A 'reel' turned moulding below. Raised on shaped and carved supports onto end plinth bases with carved paterae and 'button' feet beneath. The full-length frieze drawer fitted with a divided sectional interior. A rare and stylish table with a strikingly attractive combination of materials. In excellent original condition with a rich colour and patina. The quality and design in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster, and possibly a bespoke and unique piece made to accommodate the glass panels of a collector. The ovoid glass panels each depicting different scenes, the larger two featuring landscape and seascape scenes. The panels appear to depict European Continental scenes, possibly Italian. No damage, losses or repairs. H 30" W 24" D 10" England c.1825
