Rear hood quarter columns. A well proportioned slim case. Choice flame mahogany case veneers with boxwood line inlays and central marquetry ovals. Fluted trunk sides. An attractive, early example of an arched painted dial with raised gilt corners and a seconds dials with blued steel hands. A rarer feature of central days of the month shown with a brass hand pointer. Lunar moon phases to the arch. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Circa 1790. Robert Fulford is recorded in Ponsfords' 'Devon Clockmakers' book. Robert married Mary Clark at Stoke Damerel Parish church in 1785. This example dates to circa 1790.
