The arm ends protrude over the front posts with graceful outward curve measures at 3" wide. Attractive gently curved pierced ruyi-head splat tenons into the wide rectangular woven rattan seat. The front posts and rear stiles descend to form the legs secured by a pair of double stretchers and a front carved apron. The wood a beautiful golden honey in clear finish allows grains of elmwood and attractive patina to show though. The "Quan Yi", horseshoe chair is a symbol of prosperity and sophistication throughout the Chinese history, its timeless style remains current and highly desirable in modern interior design. Extra wide and deep for greater comfort. The chair structurally sound with no evidence of any woodworm's wonderful rich patina.
