It has a large bell bowl above a double series opaque twist stem consisting of two pairs of spiral threads outside a gauze with four equally spaced swelling knops. Conical foot. Date & Origin England, C1760. Period of George III. Condition Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration Dimensions Height: 16.5cm, Rim diameter: 7cm, Foot diameter: 7.2cm Comments This glass comes from the Michael Wallis collection which took over 45 years to build and contains over 250 drinking glasses, covering all forms from the 18th century, many exceptionally rare.
