Sits on a double series opaque twist stem consisting of a 15-ply spiral band outside a pair of spiral tapes. Conical foot. **Date & Origin** England, c1765. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration **Dimensions** Height: 18.1cm, Rim diameter: 5.8cm, Foot diameter: 7.9cm **Comments** This glass comes from the Michael Wallis collection which took over 45 years to build and contains over 250 drinking glasses, covering all forms from the 18th century, many exceptionally rare.
