Slice cutting around a solid base with polished pontil. Date & Origin England, c1820. Period of George IV. Condition Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration Dimensions Height: 10.2cm, Rim diameter: 8.3cm, Foot diameter: 7cm Comments This glass comes from the Michael Wallis collection which took over 45 years to build and contains over 250 drinking glasses, covering all forms from the 18th century, many exceptionally rare.
