Silver bowl on silver stand, joined by a closely fitting bayonet lock; the outside of the bowl is plain, half-spherical. Inside engraved in the oriental style with a view of a veiled crescent moon through fruit-tree branches, with a painter's signature and donor's inscription* **Presented by AHFAi/ compradore H&S Bank/to/John Morrison/Yokohama March 1873" Neither bowl or base marked by maker but it is an item of historical importance. Signature to the engraving inside bowl is "Tangetsusai Moriyasu", the signature of the painter Higuchi Tangetsu (1821 - 96) John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940. We are a traditional antiques shop, but very much in the 21st century. We deal in 18th and early 19th century furniture, barometers and clocks. We choose our stock for its originality and for the quality of its colour, patination and design. We are members of the BADA.
