The top is multi boarded joined by blacksmith made iron protection straps. The lid opens on a hinge to reveal a vast open storage area. The exterior has the blacksmith made long iron strap hinges. The lock plate has an iron hasp. This lovely trunk is finished all the way around and so can be used away from the wall. These are especially good as interesting coffee tables.
