A rare Art Deco commode / sideboard by Jules Leleu with ebony inlaid marquetry and bronze mounts, by Jules Leleu (1883-1961) model number 2873. French - Paris, circa 1939. A masterpiece of design and craftsmanship by the renowned Art Deco designer and influencer Jules Leleu. The shaped top over twin bowed and convex doors centre by a marquetry butterfly and floral spray of ebony veneered inlay by Messager). Each door opening to reveal a sycamore lined interior and an adjustable shelve with its edge veneered, above a gilt bronze outlined apron, raised on shaped end supports clad with gilt bronze mounts and sabots. In excellent condition and of wonderful colour retaining both of the original steel and bronze keys, an extremely rare piece by one of the key designers in beginning the Art Deco movement Jules Leleu, very reminiscence of his famous 'Feu d'artifice' commode - fireworks commode.
