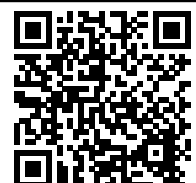
An early 20th Century decanter box formed from adapted 19th century French leather bound books. The interior is fitted with a gilt decorated glass bottle and stamped 'The Brandy Of Napoleon'. The decanter box is of very good proportions and of excellent quality. There is some wear commensurate with age to the book extremities but the exterior remains in a good condition overall. The glass bottle has some imperfections to the glass body and two hairline cracks to the neck (please see photographs) - fluid has been tested within the decanter and it remains functional with no leaks.
