Description

A finely made and stylish early 19th century mahogany sideboard in the manner of Gillows, though without a definite attribution. There are three drawers, the outer two being bow fronted with recessed panels and cross-banding, one of which is fitted as a cellarette and lined with lead. The reeded decoration is very bold, especially to the spandrels below the middle drawer which also has a central medallion with reel turned borders and two recessed panels. The legs are again reeded and have nicely shaped collars at the base. The top has, again a very bold bull-nose moulding with an attractive stripey mahogany veneer which is all a good rich colour and in excellent condition, as is the entire piece. A very striking piece of furniture that is quality through and through. If you are interested in this item, it is wise to enquire straight away.
