Description

A superb very interesting sterling silver napkin ring. It is hallmarked for Birmingham 1945 with the makers marks being rubbed. It has been engraved with the service record of a soldier or seaman from Maesycod in Wales who appears to serve in the First World War as a Royal Engineer but ends his career at HMS Vernon for the Admiralty. It should be possible to piece this together along with the initials and discover who it was presented to. It is in super condition being free from dings splits distortions and repairs. It measures approx. 1.75 inches (4.2cms) wide by 1.25 inches (3.2cms) tall 43 grams. A high quality fascinating example.
