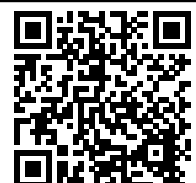

The ovoid glass body a rich ruby colour, the neck with a spring and catch mounted engraved hinged silver gilt top with vacant cartouche. Early spring-cap mechanisms is claimed to have been invented by Thomas Diller (1828-1851) and is indicative of only the best quality pieces. It is a very tactile piece of wonderful quality.
