This exquisite portrait by British artist William Moore (1790-1851) depicts a young lady wearing a beautiful white dress with gigot sleeves. It's a gentle portrayal representing the romanticised ideals of the 1830s. The portrait dates to circa 1833 when gigot sleeves were voluminous and resembled a 'leg-o-mutton'. William Moore was a notable artist and the father of Albert Moore (1841-1893). He's best known for his depiction of Charles Dickens and also referred to as William Moore of York or William Moore Senior. Learn more about William Moore in our directory. Framed and glazed.
