Set against the dramatic mountainous landscape of the Snowdonian peaks, a herder watches over cattle at the riverside, whilst on the opposite bank an angler casts his line. Alfred de Breanski was a landscape painter who was born in the St Pancras area of London, the eldest son of Leopold de Breanski, a language professor and his wife Eugenie who were both from France. His brother Gustave and his sister Julie were also talented artists. The family settled in Greenwich from where Breanski began his artistic career as a landscape painter and would go on frequent visits to the scenic areas of Britain and Wales. His work was highly accomplished for his age and he started exhibiting his paintings at the Royal Society of British Artists in 1869 and also at provincial fine art exhibitions including those held at St Andrews Hall, Norfolk in 1871.
