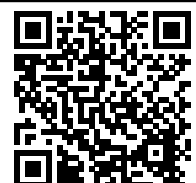
This magnificent rug was made by the Ard Kapan Qashqa'i tribe in Fars Province, south-western Persia around 1880. It comprises the popular three central lozenges and within each lozenge, can be seen the Qashqa'i 'scorpion' symbol. Beautiful, saturated natural colours abound and within the lower madder-red spandrel, can be seen the charming depiction of a stylised quadruped and peacock. This is a truly exemplary example of 19th century Qashqa'i work in very good overall condition with no repairs whatsoever. Size: 2.60m x 1.43m (8' 6" x 4' 8").
