This finely-woven bag was used to contain water-pipes or hookahs. Woven in fine soumak technique by Qashqa'i nomads during the early 20th century in Fars Province, south-west Persia, the bag is complete in beautiful natural colours and decorated at the base with tufts of wool, symbolising good-luck. This bag was recently sourced amongst the Qashqa'i and sadly, few of this quality survive today. Size: 61cm x 36cm (2' 0" x 1' 2").
