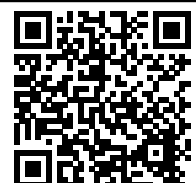
Description

Signed oil on canvas of a river landscape with cattle by the artist Bertram Priestman (1868-1951). The painting is mounted in an elegant painted frame and is monogrammed by the artist and dated 1910. Bertram Priestman was born in Bradford, Yorkshire. Studied at Slade School of Art. He travelled extensively in Europe. Exhibited regularly at the RA, Goupil Gallery, ROI, Walker Art Gallery and widely elsewhere. He was elected to the Royal Academy in 1923. Bertram studied watercolour painting under Edwin Moore (1813-1893) of York 1883-1886 and, when he left school, began an engineering course at Bradford Technical College, but gave this up to study at the Slade School of Fine Art in London where he remained for two terms under Alphonse Legros (1837-1911). Studio assistant to Sir William Llewellyn, PRA (1858-1941) who painted occasionally at Walberswick, Suffolk. Priestman exhibited at the Liverpool Academy from 1888, at the Royal Academy from 1890 when his 'In Dock for Repairs' was shown; the New English Art Club from 1894 and elsewhere. He tutored pupils including Edward Seago. He was elected to the Royal Society of British Artists in 1894; New English Art Club in 1896...
