George IV period mahogany twin-pedestal dining-table of good mellow colour; the tops with rounded corners and thumb-moulded edges, on tripods with turned shafts and splayed legs with reeded brass castors. The original loose leaf retains its iron-hinged tongue-supports. Circa 1825 48" (122cm) w, 46" (117cm) long without leaf, 68" (174cm) long with leaf, leaf 48" (122cm) w and 22 ½" (57.5cm) d, 28 ½" (72cm) h.
