Edwardian inlaid envelope card table This Edwardian inlaid rosewood envelope card table was made circa 1880. The top that opens when you swivel the top and the little button pushes up one of the flaps, so that you can open it up without damaging the top surface. Once opened the green baize playing surface is revealed as well as the counter scoops to each corner. The top is smothered in inlays, using Ivorine that looks like ivory but is mica. Once inlaid, it would then be inked in to give the definition to the design. Under the top is a drawer also that is inlaid and makes useful storage. The 4 tapering legs are joined by a shaped stretcher, with a platform for display. These Envelope card tables make brilliant bridge tables.
