The cornice top having dark red "silk" backed fret under, side windows to hood, brass capped pillars attached to hood door and matching hood rear quarter columns. Long, feather banded and book match veneered trunk door, with matching feather banded and book matched base. All set on a single strip plinth. The 12" square brass dial has a wheatear border, crown and cherub head spandrels and silvered brass chapters. The main chapter ring is engraved "Mat. Vines London" with Roman numerals and Arabic five-minute divisions. The matted centre with ringed winding holes, chamfered aperture to the silvered calendar and finely cut blued steel hands.
