Under the tabletop are 2 finely crafted full width dovetailed solid Mahogany drawers complete with moulded edges and original finely turned knobs. The drawers are lockable via their original brass locks behind brass keyhole escutcheons, complete with its original period key. This fantastic table features its beautiful original rich Mahogany colour and highly glazed french polished finish. This original table stands on twin pedestal octagonal turned support columns incorporating a relief turned collar to finish to the legs. The columns support the scroll shaped and carved legs which stand on its original brass castors. This very useful writing table is ideal to be used as a sofa table, lamp table, in a hallway or even as a desk as it has the perfect proportions.
