He used two pseudonyms as well as his own name which were Fayral on his metal sculptures and Pierre Laurel on his bronze pieces. He also studied with Max Le Verrier another well revered sculptor of this period and Marcel Bouraine . All three sculptors studied together at Beaux Arts in Geneva, Switzerland.
