Each candelabra features floral and leaf branches with detachable sconces above beautifully sculpted cherubic central columns with inverted baluster Bleu Céleste columns below. The bleu celeste bases have panels of hand painted country flowers with gilt highlights raised on stepped circular bases on tripartite feet. There is no mistaking their unique quality and design which is sure to be cherished by any admirer of ornamental porcelain.
