A mid Georgian period, mahogany tilt-top tripod supper table, dating from the late C18th. A solid round mahogany top with lipped pie-crust edge, with tilt mechanism. Supported by a well proportioned turned stem with writhed carving to the base, raised on a tripod of cabriole legs on pad feet. A attractive table with several flaws, good overall colour and polish, and ready for use. Cleaned and waxed. Dimensions: This table measures approximately 72 cm (28.5") tall, and 84 cm (33") in diameter. Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - This table is in reasonable condition, commensurate with its age, and is structurally sound and sturdy. Good overall colour. Top and base are likely a marriage, though of similar ages. Top with marks, blemishes and a couple of repairs. Repairs to under stretchers and block. Base is good. Ready for use. - As with all vintage & antique furniture there will be signs of use, marks, wear & tear, etc.

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
