Finely and brightly painted colourful enamel decoration with opposing large panels depicting traditional scenes of court life, surrounded and interspersed with various motifs, flower-heads and vignettes. The neck with smaller opposing and differing court scene panels. The top of the neck and the base, decorated with differing bands of decoration. The sides of the neck with applied gilded mythical guardian lion 'foo' dogs. The tall flared neck onto a swelling bulbous body, with an unusual overlapped or 'cuffed' design feature.
