The neck with a spring and catch mounted engraved hinged silver lid, incrustated with coral cabochons. The centre with initialled cartouche. The early spring-cap mechanism is claimed to have been invented by Thomas Diller (1828-1851) and is indicative of only the best quality pieces. The base star incised. Hallmarks: Unmarked as it was very often the case with scent bottle lids but tested as silver. Dimensions: Length: 8cm - 3 inches. Diameter: 2.7cm - 1 inch. Condition: Glass in very good condition.
