Description

A superb English antique solid sterling silver mounted noggin decanter. It is hallmarked for Birmingham 1919 with the makers marks being that of Mappin & Webb. It has been beautifully made having a glass base with a sterling silver mounted rim and lid, this bulbous design is very unusual. It is used to hold a small amount of whisky or brandy on a bedside of fireside table rather than use the large decanter. It is in superb condition with the silver being free from splits repairs and dings. The glass is free from cracks chips and repairs. It measures approx. 3.25 inches (8.3cm) tall by 1.75 inches (4.5cm) wide and weighs 80 grams. A beautiful usable piece.
