The jardiniere is serpentine in shape with ormolu mounts enclosing an enchanting hand painted and gilded Sevres porcelain plaque with Bleu Celeste borders featuring a reclining cherub, with a pierced brass gallery, ormolu handles and mounts and the original tin liner. It is from Chantilly that a cadre of workers migrated to the Chateau de Vincennes near Paris to form a larger porcelain manufactory in 1738. French King Louis XV, perhaps inspired by his rumoured relationship with mistress, Madame de Pompadour, took an intense interest in porcelain and m...

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
