The inlay and marquetry on this table is most likely to have been undertaken by The Blake Family upon instructions from Baldock. Edward Holmes Baldock (1777-1845) Born on the 14th May 1777 he established his business in 1805 in Hanway Street which over the years he expanded at this location. He soon was a prominent London furniture dealer to several members of the Royal Family and is responsible for supplying French-fashioned furniture t...
