It has been superbly designed and has been engraved with a crest used by the Boyd and Kassye Families. It is in super condition having no dings splits distortions or repairs. It measures over 11 inches (28.3cms) long by almost 2.25 inches (5.3cm) wide and weighs an impressive 125 grams. A very high quality rare and interesting piece.
