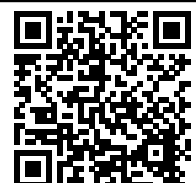
Description

Royal Worcester porcelain vase and cover, painted by Harry Stinton, dated 1912. Hand painted to the centre, with an oval gilt beaded panel of Lowland cattle in a river landscape, on a cobalt blue ground. The vase having twin branch handles, moulded with cherry blossom, acanthus leaf moulding to the body, and set upon a square pedestal foot. Surmounted by a circular domed cover, with a branch finial, heightened in gilt. Signed – H. Stinton. Printed puce factory mark, date mark for 1912, model number 2366 to the base. Height: 22 cm, 8 5/8". Width: 8.5 cm, 3 1/4". Depth: 6.3 cm, 2 1/2". Condition: Excellent.
