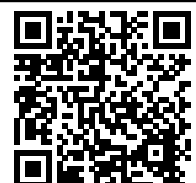
Description

Super 1920's advertising chair for 'Holdfast Boots', made by the renowned and innovative German chair designer Michael Thonet. Thonet made famous the process of bending normally brittle woods such as Beech, and his 'bent wood' chairs, are celebrated worldwide particularly the design classic bistro chairs still popular to this day. This chair has the trademark bent wood frame with a burnished plywood seat bearing the advertising logo for 'Holdfast Boots and Shoes'. The colour is glorious with a golden honey rich back contrasting beautifully with the dark finish of the seat legs and sides. The chair stands 89cm tall, 37cm across the widest part of the seat and 38.5cm from front to back. The chair has the gentle surface wear that is to be expected of a well loved item of furniture of this age, but it looks fantastic and would be a wonderful and stylish addition to any home.
