Description

Antique silver Visible pocket watch, 1918. The watch has a 17-jewel stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The movement is signed Visible, and it has the number 51589 which implies a brevet or patent number but there is no published record of such a patent. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover which has a little unevenness and minor scratching. The watch measures 51mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the two case backs for London (import mark), 1918, together with a sponsor's mark for William Sparrow. The case is in good condition, just a couple of small indentations to the back of the watch. The acrylic lens is in lovely condition. The dial is in super condition with original blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and outer minute markers. The watch comes in a new presentation box.
