This is a large antique Victorian hall umbrella, hat and coat stand, circa 1860 in date. The hall stand is made of solid mahogany and features a demi-lune shaped pediment and a scrolled plume above two horizontal chamfered rails with nine turned mahogany coat hooks. The bottom rail supporting a curved tubular brass rail with a metal-lined oval drip tray below. The coat stand is raised on a plinth base. It is a stylish yet very practical item which would look lovely in any hall. Condition: In excellent condition, please see photos for confirmation. Mahogany has been used for centuries in ship building, house building, furniture making etc and is the core structure of just about every 19th century vanity box, dressing case or jewellery box. It became more of a Victorian trend to dress Mahogany with these decorative veneers, such as Burr Walnut and Coromandel, so that the actual Mahoga...

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
