The garnets are foil backed, which was a popular manufacturing method of the time, whilst the diamonds are open backed, allowing light to flood in to create the perfect glimmer complimenting the deep reds of the garnet. A latch back fitting ensures that they stay safely in your ear. These earrings ooze with charm and character and are a rare find in such wonderful condition.
