These charming scent bottles were sold containing small amounts of perfume and were intended to be thrown away after use, making it a rare item nowadays. This large example is in a rare petrol blue colorway. The body is four sided with gilded moon and star decoration and jeweled additions. The bottle dates from the late Georgian period circa 1830 and unusually, retains the original glass penny shaped stopper. A charming collectors piece. Dimensions below.
