Description

This most ingenious and decorative box is finely made from solid oak. It has an unusual rise and fall mechanism which cleverly loads a small pencil from its interior onto the central scalloped platform when the fall position is level with the top surface. It is used to hold a collection of eight small pencils for scoring at a bridge card game. The exterior is decoratively silver mounted. Each mount is ornately shaped and everyone is hallmarked one of the larger side mounts also includes the Birmingham makers mark for J Collyer and Co Ltd (1902 – 1912) adding both the style and strength of this box Birmingham 1909 -10.
