Description

This most impressive large scale Edwardian desk ink well was produced by the highly acclaimed silversmiths, Walker and Hall and it is clearly marked on the edge of the base. The square form silver plated base is stepped and has a deep dragooned moulding around the recess for which the heavy cut glass ink well fits. The glass body is beautifully hand cut and the top has fluted scallops around its rim to rest a pen. The base is decoratively hand cut with a diamond pattern. The domed silver plated lid hinges from the matching collar and is all in very good original condition with some minor small marks showing light use. No chips or damage to the glass.
