The spoon is good quality, weighing approximately 27g and measuring approximately 5" (13cm) long. It is clearly hallmarked for London, 1834 and the makers Joseph & Albert Savory. It is in good condition for its age. There are no major damages and it displays well. There are some faint surface scratches and a few light marks and dinks here and there but nothing detrimental. It has been gently cleaned and polished and is ready for use. The best description comes from the photos so please look at them all carefully and if you have any questions just ask.
