Description

Herbert Royle (1870-1958) was a British landscape painter, born in Patricroft, Lancashire. He trained at the Harris Institute in Preston and Southport school of art under John William Buxton Knight. He exhibited extensively at the Walker gallery, Liverpool, Manchester city art gallery, Royal Academy and at other Galleries and Exhibitions throughout the Country. From 1924 onwards he lived at the Manor House in the hamlet of Nesfield, near Ilkley, where he also had a studio on the hillside above the house. Some of his finest work was painted in this area around his home in Wharfedale. "The Edge of the Wood", "Nesfield Dene from Studio" is a charming freely painted oil on board measuring 12"x 16". It is signed lower right and is framed in a quality gilt frame giving an overall size of 17"x 21". A lovely painting of Nesfield, Wharfedale, close to the artist's home in Yorkshire. This painting was exhibited at the R.A. in 1948.
