The late 19th century weavers came from villages outside of Ushak and employed tribal techniques. Paramount to these techniques was the use of larger knots on these carpets (sometimes less than 30 knots per square inch) and an all-wool foundation. This is why Ushaks have a soft loose feel and their designs are more often very open. Woven with exquisite faded pinks, peach tones, golden yellows and rare green dyes, it is perfect for a bedroom, study or drawing room looking for a subtle calm look. In wonderful original condition, with only small areas of wear.
