Having a high crown, inset with panels of a seated Buddha. Her hair tied in a top knot. The figure retains a substantial amount of its original gilding. Height: 21.5 cm, 8 1/2". Width: 10 cm, 4". Depth: 8 cm, 3 1/8". Condition: Age related wear to the gilding. Excellent condition. No repair.
