Description

This is good early 19th century French fruitwood confiture cupboard. The cupboard originates from Nicolas Sarkozy's home town of Picardy, where it is believed, he is still popular in some quarters. The cupboard has a cleated top and all the sides are of tenon construction with pegged joints. There is a typical roughly constructed drawer with low relief carved leaf decoration on the panel, above the spacious open cupboard with two integral adjustable shelves. The corners of the cupboard are rounded and have reeded decoration, while the door has a carved roundel and more leaf carved decoration. The feet are scoll carved to match the decorative apron and finish off what is a delightful piece with a lovely rich patinated look.
