Description

Pair of late C19th French marquetry inlaid and ormolu mounted 'tables-en-chiffonniere'. Pair of Louis XVI period revival oval tables in the manner of the C18th celebrated master ebeniste Charles Topino. Inlaid with complex marquetry panels and designs with walnut, kingwood, rosewood, ebony and satinwood. Of free-standing form with decorative pierced brass-galleried edge tops. One table fitted a single drawer with cupboard below enclosing a single leather-lined shelf, simulated as drawer fronts, the other table fitted 3 drawers, each table with kidney-shaped marquetry inlaid under-tiers fitted with brass galleries. Cast ormolu escutcheons and sabots. Supplied with original key. In excellent condition with original surface and a mellow colour and patina. Superb quality pair of decorative and practical tables which could be utilised in a multitude of settings. H 31" W 20" D 14" France c.1890
